

Volunteers Needed For ADHD Research

We are conducting a research study looking at the effect of stimulant medication and/or neurofeedback on concentration abilities in children who have ADHD.

What Would I Have To Do If I Took Part?

The study has 3 parts:

1. Meet the researcher at the Learning Assessment and Neurocare Centre for 2 hours to complete questionnaires, a brain wave reading and a computer concentration test.
2. Receive your usual treatment at the Learning Assessment and Neurocare Centre (stimulant medication and/or neurofeedback) for 15 weeks.
3. After 15 weeks, meet with the researcher again for 2 hours to complete further questionnaires, a brain wave reading and a computer concentration test.



A family's involvement in this study would be of significant value. The findings will hopefully benefit the understanding and progression of treatment in the field of conditions involving attention difficulties.



Who Can Take Part?

You can take part if:

- If you are a patient at the Learning Assessment and Neurocare Centre
- Your child is aged between 7 and 17 years old
- Your child has a diagnosis of ADHD, combined subtype
- Your child is only taking stimulant medication (i.e methylphenidate such as Concerta XL, Equasym XL, MedikineXL or Ritalin)
- Or your child is receiving neurofeed back
